Job Description

Purpose:

To be responsible for the general health and safety of campers and staff.
To improve health care skills of campers.

Qualifications:

At least 18 years of age.
State licensed RN, LPN, PA
Readiness and ability to adapt to camp work situation.
Emotional stability to meet emergencies with good judgement.
Interest and ability to inspire confidence in children.
Knowledge of the safe use and storage of medicines and equipment.

Responsible to: Head Nurse

Responsibilities:

1. Attend pre-camp training.
2. Comply with personnel policies for seasonal camp staff.
3. Ensure safe use of insulin and blood testing equipment and supplies.
4. Assist with testing and insulin administration.
5. Provide first aid.
6. Maintain records, insurance forms, and log book.
7. Participate in infirmary housekeeping duties.
8. Assist with screening of incoming campers and staff.
9. Relay medical problems to Head Nurse or Medical Director.
