

WATERFRONT ASSISTANT OR AIDE

Job Description

Purpose:

To ensure the health and safety of campers during aquatic activities.
To ensure campers have an enjoyable aquatic experience.

Qualifications:

At least 16 years of age.
Ability to work with children.
Holder of Lifeguard Training, CPR, and Standard First Aid certification – or the equivalent.
Ability to work cooperatively as a team member.
Demonstration of skill in rescue and emergency specific to aquatic activities.

Responsible to: Waterfront Director and Assistant Camp Director

Responsibilities:

1. Participate in pre-camp training.
2. Comply with personnel policies for camp staff.
3. Assist in maintaining ACA standards for aquatic programs.
4. Participate in the general camp program.
5. Work cooperatively with other staff members.
6. Ensure the health and safety of all campers.
7. Participate in the opening and closing of waterfront areas.
8. Assist with waterfront programs in accordance with Red Cross standards.
9. Assist with testing all campers for skill levels before program activities can occur.
10. Assist in maintaining pool and lake areas including testing and sanitation.
11. Assist in establishing recreational aquatic activities.
12. Maintain necessary records and complete requested forms and reports.
13. Participate in staff meetings during camp week.
14. Relay problems to Waterfront Director or Assistant Camp Director.
